Scope and objectives

In this workshop you will learn essential strategies and tools to frame and write successful grant proposals and scientific papers that make an impact on the intended audience. The workshop is interactive, with discussions and exercises used throughout to help you learn through practice.

At the end of the workshop you will understand:

- Key cognitive processes readers use to process information
- A technique to frame your research for different audiences
- Narrative techniques to shape scientific stories
- What funders/reviewers and editors/readers want to see in grant applications and scientific papers, respectively
- Elements of successful grant writing
- A step-by-step approach to conveying meaning at multiple levels in scientific papers

Workshop leader

Dr. Dan Csontos. Dan is the Editorial Director of Elevate Scientific. At Elevate, he has helped secure over 3 billion SEK in funding in the past 7 years, from national (e.g. VR, Formas), European (e.g. ERC, H2020) and private (e.g. KAW, Novo Nordisk Foundation) funders, and helped develop scientific papers that have been published in the world's top journals. Before founding Elevate, Dan was an editor with *Nature* and *Nature Physics*, and an editor-at-large for *Nature Communications*. He holds a PhD in physics from Lund University (Sweden) and has conducted postdoctoral research at Ohio University (USA) and Massey University (New Zealand).
